DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product contains a temporary, non-staining colorant which marks spray application. The colour breaks down with sunlight and moisture.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Shake well before adding to water. Do not mix more than is required and do not store mixed products overnight. Apply as a fine spray to plant foliage using flat fan spraying tips. Turf Mark can be mixed with commonly used herbicides, insecticides and fungicides.

MIXING

Add the required amount of product directly to the spray tank and mix well.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT

Do not allow chemical containers or spray to get into drains, sewers, ponds or streams.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep out of reach of children. Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsing to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the container below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose, clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.
