

GENERAL INFORMATION: Spraying is time consuming and expensive so making sure your sprays are effective is very important. MAXi-BUFF is designed to improve the uptake and translocation of foliar nutrients and other sprays. MAXi-BUFF rapidly and very simply corrects spray alkalinity to pH 4.5 which is understood to be the optimum pH for foliar nutrient uptake. MAXi-BUFF also converts hard water calcium and magnesium salts into micro-nutrients which is a unique and very useful feature.

HOW TO USE: MAXi-BUFF must be added in the spray solution after foliar fertilizers and before pesticides. Add MAXi-BUFF in small quantities to the spray water with continuous agitation until the colour turns from clear to green pH 7-6 and purple pH 5.0-4.5. Typically 250ml of MAXi-BUFF will reduce 100L of solution from pH 8 to pH 4.5.

If the tank content cannot be visualized, take a 1L sample of the spray solution and slowly trickle MAXi-BUFF into the measuring container while agitating. Measure the quantity of MAXi-BUFF added to get to a stable purple colour of the 1L sample. Multiply that number by the number of litres in the tank and add that quantity of MAXi-BUFF to the tank. The amount of MAXi-BUFF to add will depend on the hardness of water. Harder water requires higher concentrations of MAXi-BUFF. To prevent overdosing, MAXi-BUFF does not acidify solutions beyond pH 3 no matter how much product is added.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT: DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

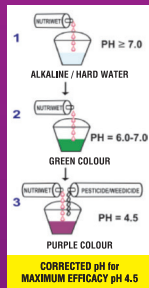
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in the closed, original container, in a well ventilated area as cool as possible. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple, or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on-site. Break, crush, puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If not available, bury below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, vegetation and roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS: Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Wash hands after use as pH indicator may cause staining.
